What is the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation (OVR)?

OVR helps people with disabilities obtain the skills and resources needed to get a job, keep a job, and develop a career.

We assist people with a **broad range of disabilities** such as:

- Low vision or blindness
- Deafness or auditory condition
- Mental or emotional disorders
- Orthopedic impairments
- Head or spinal injuries
- Renal disease
- Diabetes
- Epilepsy
- Learning disorders

ELIGIBILITY FOR ILOB

- A person who has a significant disability (physical or mental impairment with one or more functional limitations)
- The corrected visual acuity in the better eye must fall: 20/60-200 Low Vision 20/200-400 Blindness
- Must be 55 years old or older on the date of the application

FINANCIAL NEED

There is a financial needs test at OVR, so you may be required to contribute to the cost of some services.

- Job guidance
- Career counseling
- Professional training
- Job placement
- Physical or mental restoration
- Assistive rehab technology services or device
- Occupational equipment
- Personal reader, interpreter, or scribe services
